



## CODE OF CONDUCT

Both the governing body and administration have a very important role to support all members of the university in achieving their potential while meeting the objectives of the university.

Specifically, in discharging their duties, they should:

- Be models of integrity of character, honesty, righteousness and truthfulness.
  - Ensure fairness, impartiality, absence of prejudice, non-discrimination, equal opportunity, embrace.
  - Encourage all members of the community abide by laws of the country and state.
  - Exhibit selflessness while discharging their university responsibilities.
  - Place universities requirements above their individual preferences.
1. Ensure that all campuses have a common philosophy that drives their growth and that all campuses are unified as a single entity under the university vision and mission.
  2. Ensure that administrative heads are fully supported in promoting the vision and mission of the university and given the tools and resources to do so.
  3. Ensure that the university is meeting the needs of society by designing its academic programs so as to stay relevant and so as to train students to address current problems and challenges.
  4. Ensure that there is academic and research excellence in all of its campuses.
  5. Oversee the preparation of the university annual report.
  6. Handle and address any university level situations that may impact the overall health of the university.
  7. Facilitate the smooth interaction between university, state and nation to ensure that the university is well positioned to serve the needs of the state and the state and country.
  8. Students should receive information about the maintenance of acceptable academic standing, graduation requirements, and individual course syllabi and requirements.
  9. In all instances of general discipline, academic discipline, and academic evaluation, students have the right to fair and impartial treatment.
  10. Students are free to represent their grievances to the authorities and can be assured that they will not be singled out for doing so.
