## ABOUT AIFD

The Army Institute of Fashion & Design (AIFD) was established in Bangalore on October 4, 2004 under the aegis of the **Army Welfare Education Society (AWES)** to impart quality education in the field of Fashion and Design to the wards of Army Personnel, both serving and retired. It is one of twelve leading institutes of higher education managed by AWES which also manages 137 Army Public schools and 249 Army Pre-Primary Schools all over the country.

AIFD is located in Nagareshwara Nagenahalli near Kothanur in the sylvan Garden City – **Bangalore**. The locality is a fast growing part of Bangalore East, easily accessible to the airport, with several prestigious educational institutes and housing projects in the near vicinity. Bangalore is one of the main hubs of Fashion in India, with many designers hailing from here. The Garment manufacturing industry is also based in and around the city.

So come to AIFD to discover an atmosphere of academic excellence focused on both academic and professional goals. The students have consistently performed at the University level, bagging an average of 40% of the ranks declared each year. (The university declares a total of 10 ranks each year. This year, the rank list has not yet been released because of the delay due to the late conducting of examinations because of the pandemic.)

Karnataka has implemented the flexible 4 year NEP (National Education Policy) degree from the 2021-22 academic year. AIFD offers two courses – a four year B.Sc degree in Fashion & Apparel Design and a four year B.Sc degree in Interior Design & Decoration. The institute is affiliated to Bengaluru North University. The present syllabus has been created by a state level team of experts. The HOD of the institute is part of the State NEP team. While following the curriculum and the syllabi set by the University impeccably, the institute also offers value added courses to enrich the curriculum and broaden the knowledge of the students, which serves to increase their employability quotient. As mentioned earlier, the dynamic Institute Academic Advisory Committee helps in inviting experts for special lectures and workshops.

The B.Sc Interior Design & Decoration Course offers an extensive knowledge of both basic and advanced interior designing ideas to create the best possible spaces for clients.

One of the positive gains of the pandemic is the development and utilization of online mode of communication. Throughout the lockdown, the institute had conducted webinars with experts. This has continued even after lockdown, enabling the students to benefit from experts across the country.

Karnataka is the first state in the country to implement the National Education Policy (NEP). The four year degree implemented from the academic year 2021-22 is flexible and allows multiple exit points for the awarding of Certificate, Diploma, Degree and Degree with Honours. As envisioned in the NEP 2020 – the syllabus offers holistic education & all round development under the Choice Based System (CBCS). AIFD is affiliated to Bengaluru North University and has been involved in the charting of the curriculum to be followed by all design institutes in Karnataka. AIFD, apart from following the syllabi, offers additional courses and special lectures keeping in mind the excellent infrastructure available to the students and the strong relationship with the stalwarts of the industry. While adhering to the rules and regulations of the University, the Institute has developed its own methods of offering value enriched courses to the students. The Institute has further reduced the number of students per batch, keeping in mind the norms of social distancing during the current pandemic situation.

The B.Sc course in Interior Design & Decoration is being introduced from the upcoming academic year. After completing this course, graduates have a wide range of job opportunities available to them. This includes Job Profiles as Interior designers, Interior decorators, Landscape designers and 3D Artists.

Students are encouraged to do internships and projects. The Placement Cell will assist in providing Internships in various areas of interest.



## INFRASTRUCTURE AT AIFD

The Fashion and Apparel sector in India, like many other industries in 2021 was adversely affected by the lockdown. While the sector has been developing rapidly due to the constant support of the Ministry of Textiles, the pandemic and the rise of the work-from-home lifestyle has reduced the demand for non-essential spending, especially clothing and accessories. However, with the vaccine and things slowly getting back to normal, the garment sector is seeing an encouraging growth.

With every passing year new designers/fashion professionals are arriving on the fashion scene. While India has always been the source of rich heritage textiles and craftsmen, Indian designers are finally getting international acclaim. They are breaking new ground and setting fresh goals and using social media with panache. The Apparel industry is the second largest industry in India and provides employment to several million people. With their impressive growth, the industry has also started implementing sustainable growth practises – the burning need of the hour.

Rather than following the dictates of fast fashion, production is now slowing down. Designers are rethinking their design practises, working on incorporating sustainable practises into their design model. This is not just about being creative –technical skills have to be honed as well. The Contemporary designer needs to be research oriented, with a social conscience. It is also imperative that the designer is finely tuned into the needs of a market whether prêt or haute couture.

The Institute does not just follow the set curriculum (which is revised every three years) but also provides additional information to the student by means of specialized lectures, workshops and interactions with the industry. The Visual Merchandising Lab and Fashion Photography Labs have the best facilities available for the student to explore opportunities in diverse fields.

# FACILITIES AT AIFD

## **PATTERNMAKING & SEWING LAB**

There are two labs with 30 state of the art industrial sewing machines each, one on the ground floor and the other on the first. Students are given hands on training on these machines. In addition there are computerized sewing machines for doing specialized work. Both labs are attached to pattern making labs, stocked with pattern making tables and several types of dress forms, enabling the student to both draft patterns or drape their designs on the dress forms. The embroidery machine allows students to conceptualize their motifs on the computer and realize the patterns with as many as sixteen different colours at the same time.

## **CAD / IT LAB**

The CAD Lab has over 50 PC systems including 40 PC systems exclusively for design application with software like – Adobe Photo Shop, Illustrator and Corel Draw which enhance illustration skills of the students. 20 PC systems are earmarked for specialized training in GERBER, CAD and ERP (Enterprise Resource Planning). Institute is also subscribing to WGSN, an online fashion forecasting service to train and equip the students with the very latest input into current news in the fashion world.

### **QUALITY CONTROL LAB**

The QC lab has the facilities to conduct all quality tests for fibre, yarn, fabric, garments and accessories. All high end machines as per industry specifications have been installed in the lab and the students are trained on all machines so that they can take up the responsibilities immediately after they join industry.

### **VISUAL MERCHANDISING & DRAPING LAB**

AIFD is the only Fashion Institute in the country to have a full fledged Visual Merchandising Lab. This includes VM Windows, with mannequins, spotlights and prop making materials. The institute invites experts to conduct VM workshops on a regular basis, with Visual Merchandising being one of the most lucrative careers open to Design graduates.

### **PHOTOGRAPHY LAB**

With Fashion Photography becoming an integral part of the fashion curriculum, being required for fashion styling, and e-commerce, the institute has set up a state of the art Photography lab, with the latest equipment and cameras. Students are encouraged to use the equipment for individual assignments, thus making them explore their creative and business side.

## **DYEING & FINISHING LAB**

This lab has Chemical testing facilities to train the students in identification of materials, yarn dyeing, sample fabric dyeing and printing. The lab consists of the latest 12 kg capacity fabric and garment dyeing machine, Hydro extractor, tumble dryer and a Brushing Robot Machine (Vertical type) for denim trouser finishing as per user requirement. Recently the lab has been upgraded with a Softflow Dyeing machine.

## **GARMENT PROCESSING LAB**

The Industry is working towards reducing the lead time of delivery. The Institute has state of the art technology to train students on garment dyeing and finishing.

## **LIBRARY**

The Institute Library is well equipped with several books & Journals covering fashion, textiles, apparel, computers & management. It is also equipped with wi-fi internet connectivity and reprographic and scanning facilities. AIFD subscribes to several international & national magazines and journals. WGSN, the subscribed online fashion forecasting service can be accessed from the library as well. The Institute is subscribing to e-books and e-magazines related to Fashion.

## CAFETERIA

The cafeteria is situated within the campus and offers wholesome food at competitive charges. The student mess committee decides the menu, taking into consideration the demands of the students.

## OTHER FACILITIES & AMENITIES

- (a) Loan Facilities. Students can avail educational loan from any nationalized banks situated at their home town. Institute will provide all the necessary documents for obtaining educational loan from the respective bank.
- (b) Opening of Bank Account. Parents are advised to open Bank Account in the name of their ward preferably in their home town which students can operate through ATM.
- (c) Laboratories. All the laboratories of the institute are kept open on demand from 0900 – 2100 hrs including weekends.
- (d) Sports Facilities. Institute has indoor & outdoor sports facilities for the overall development of the students.
- (e) Hostel. Separate Boys & Girls Hostel. The New Girls Hostel was inaugurated in June 2019. The Girls Hostel has an exclusive cafeteria and well equipped Gym on the ground floor. Outdoor sports facilities exclusively for girls within the large central courtyard. The Boys cafeteria is adjacent to the hostel. Students are not permitted to keep two wheelers during the course of study.

(f) Additional support. Institute regularly invites experts from industry to deliver special lectures on different topics & also conducts personality development programs.

(g) Annual Events. Design Dapple (Annual event to provide a platform to show case the talent of young designers in front of fashion experts) & Chrysalis (a national level student’s design competition organised by the Institute) are the annual mega events to provide a platform to the students to show case their creativity in the form of fashion show. Usually, both events take place on a mega scale, in an auditorium in the heart of the city in front of an audience numbering 600 to 800. However, due to the ban on large social gathering in 2020, the scaled down version of Design Dapple was conducted in the campus itself as a part of the Graduation Day. The graduating designers presented the collections themselves, with the juniors contributing cultural performances and reminiscences online.



## COMPUTER BASED ONLINE ADMISSION TEST (OAT) DETAILS, ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION & WEIGHTAGE FOR GALLANTRY AWARDS

### 1.1. Date and Time of OAT (Online Admission Test)

The Online Admission Test (OAT) 2022 for admission to the UG Course offered by the AIFD Bangalore, will be held on Sunday, 29 May 2022 from 1430 hrs to 1730 hrs at notified examination centres as per Para 3.1 of the prospectus. The candidates will be required to report at their respective examination centres at 1400 hrs i.e. at least half an hour before the commencement of the WAT.

1.2. Eligibility for Admission to AIFD: Admission to the Army Institute of Fashion and Design is for the children of eligible serving Army personnel, eligible ex Army personnel and wards of war widows/widows of the Army. The children of under mentioned categories of Army personnel are eligible and they are required to submit the relevant certificate as given against the category applicable to them as proof of their eligibility for admission to Army Institute of Fashion and Design along with the Application Form.

(a) The applicants must fall into one of the following categories :-

(i) Children of serving Army personnel with minimum 10 years continuous service in the Army (Submit Certificate No 1).

(ii) Children of ex Army personnel granted / awarded regular pension, liberalized family pension, family pension or disability pension at the time of their superannuation, demise, discharge, release medical board / invalid Medical Board. This includes wards of recruits medically boarded out and granted disability pension. (Submit Certificate No 1).

(b) Adopted / Step Children and Children of Re-married Widows :-

(i) Adopted child of Army personnel if adopted at least five years prior to seeking admission. (Submit Certificate No 2).

(ii) Step children are eligible provided they are born from a wedding where at least one parent belonged to the Army who is otherwise eligible. (Submit Certificate No 2).

(c) Eligibility Criteria in Special Cases:-

(i) Eligibility Criteria for Wards of Ex Army Medical Corps Officers / Army Dental Corps Officers Presently Serving with Indian Navy or Indian Air Force (IN / IAF). Wards of only those ex Army medical officers / Army Dental Corps officers presently serving with Indian Navy or Indian Air Force who have served with the Army for 10 years (Submit Certificate No 3).

(ii) Eligibility Criteria for Children of APS / MNS / TA Personnel (Submit Certificate No 3).

(aa) Wards of APS personnel classified as ex-servicemen as per Govt of India, Ministry of Defence letter No 9 (52)/88/D (Res) dated 19 Jul 89.

(ab) Children of those APS personnel who are on deputation and who have put in 10 years of service in the Army.

(ac) Children of APS personnel, who are directly recruited into APS who have completed 10 years of service and of those who as per their terms and conditions of service, retired from APS without reversion to P&T Department after completing their minimum pensionable service of which 10 years was in the Army.

(ad) Children of only those members of MNS who have 10 years service as regular members of MNS or are in receipt of pension from the Army.

(ae) Children of only those TA personnel who have completed 10 years of Embodied Service.

(af) Wards of IN and IAF personnel, both serving and retired.

(ag) Wards of serving personnel of Assam Rifles

(ah) Wards of civ. Based on a valid NIFT / OAT score of AIFD

The eligibility mentioned in af, ag & ah are under consideration and will be applicable / implemented only on approval of HQ AWES, Delhi

1.3. Educational Qualifications.

The applicant must have passed 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Std having studied same combination for two years regular students with a minimum of 35% aggregate marks from a board recognized by UGC/University. Bengaluru North University norms will be followed with regard to admission approval, refund of fees and retention of original documents from time to time. Candidates who have passed their 10+2 examination as a regular candidate are only eligible for admission to B.Sc. (FAD) and B.Sc (IDD) as per Bengaluru North University norms. Candidates who have passed through distance education system or privately through NIOS (National Institute of Open Schooling) have to offer the same combination of subjects in both 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Standard. Admission through Online Admission Test (OAT).

1.4. **Physical Fitness.** Besides fulfilling the eligibility conditions as per Para 1, the candidate should be certified by MH / RMO / Registered Medical Practitioner as physically and mentally fit to pursue the course. A certificate to this effect in the enclosed form Appendix H is required to be submitted by the candidates at the time of admission.

1.5. **Weightage to Gallantry Award Winners.** The wards of Gallantry Award Winners will be given weightage in admissions as under. Such candidates are required to submit the necessary proof to that effect for being considered for the weightage as per note 2 given below :-

**Note :** 1. The above-mentioned percentage of the respective gallantry award winner's ward's OAT score will be added to his/ her actual OAT score before drawing the overall merit list.

2. A certified copy of the part II Order / Gazette notification conferring the award / copy of the award certificate should be attached with the application form for claiming the weightage. For Sena Medal (Gallantry) a certificate has to be obtained from MS – X that the Sena Medal awarded to the Officer is for acts of courage / bravery.

1.6. Ensuring Eligibility is Candidate's Responsibility : It is the responsibility of the candidate to ensure that he / she possesses the requisite academic qualifications for the course and is eligible in all other respects as per the eligibility conditions given in this prospectus. The fact that a candidate has been permitted to appear in OAT does not imply that his / her eligibility has been verified and accepted. The eligibility of the candidates will be verified by AIFD at the time of admission to the course as also later during the scrutiny of papers by the university. In case of any change in the eligibility conditions made by the university for the session 2022-23 at a later stage, the eligibility will be verified with reference to the university's eligibility conditions prescribed at the time of candidate's admission to AIFD. **If a candidate is found to be ineligible at any time before or after the commencement of course, the College reserves the right to cancel his / her candidature without any refund of the fees / charges paid.**

(a) All admissions made by AIFD, Bangalore are provisional. Admission will be considered final only when the eligibility criteria are met and original documents / certificates produced by the student for verification and subject to approval by Bengaluru North University.

(b) All disputes regarding sale of prospectus, conduct of examination, admission to AIFD or any other matter pertaining to Army Institute of Fashion & Design, Bangalore shall fall within the jurisdiction of the courts in Bangalore.

#### 1.7. Submission of Original Documents

Note:- 1. As per instructions received from Bangalore North University, original documents should NOT BE LAMINATED. Admission will be rejected if original documents are laminated.

2. The website link of Online results should be submitted along with a printed screen shot of the online results clearly reflecting the candidates name and roll no. This has to be submitted along with 12<sup>th</sup> Std passing certificate. This is to enable the University to verify the certificates through the website link provided by the students.

## JOINING INSTRUCTIONS

### 2.1 Admission :

The result of the OAT published on **10 Jun 2022** will be put up on the AIFD website [aifd.edu.in](http://aifd.edu.in). The result will also be displayed in the College Notice Board. Candidates declared to have passed OAT will also be individually informed by AIFD Bangalore to this effect. The short listed students will be required to pay the Course Registration Fee of **Rs.10,000/- & Rs 5000/-** for hostel, on or before **17 Jun 2022** (within 7 days of publishing of the OAT Results on the web site). (Refer para 2.7 for paying fees) After the receipt of registration fee from the willing candidates, final list of admission will be announced in the Institute web site on **20 Jun 2021**.

### 2.2 General :

The registration amount will be adjusted against the first installment of the fee for the course to be paid by the candidate at the time of admission. If the registration / confirmation fee is not paid by due date, it will be assumed that the candidate is not willing to join the course and the offer made to the candidate will be treated as cancelled. The seat in such a situation will be offered to the candidate next on the waiting list. The candidate will be permitted to join the course only after he / she pays his / her dues by the due date. If a candidate fails to pay the requisite fee, as declared in the prospectus and / or fails to join the course by the due date, his / her candidature will be treated as cancelled and the seat will be offered to the candidate next in the waiting list. Request for seeking extension in time for joining the course will not be entertained.

### 2.3 Documents to be submitted at the time of admission.

The following certificates will be submitted by the candidate at the time of admission / reporting to Institute:-

(a)	Both 11 <sup>th</sup> Std and 12 <sup>th</sup> Std Marks Card (having studied same combination for two years)	-	Original

#### 2.4 Custody of Original Certificates.

All original certificates, as mentioned above, will have to be produced by the candidate for verification of his eligibility for admission to the AIFD UG Course. These will be produced on the day of admission and will thereafter be retained by AIFD Bangalore. Candidates are advised to apply / approach the University where they appeared for the last examination and obtain their Migration Certificate well in time. Admission may be denied if the migration certificate is not produced at the time of joining the college or within one month of commencement of the course. All the original marks card of 10<sup>th</sup> ,11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> will be retained at the institute till the admission approval from the university. After the approval of the candidature, originals will be returned to the students.

#### 2.5 Inability to Produce Original Documents at the Time of Admission.

In case a candidate is already pursuing a course of study in some other institute and the original certificates are held elsewhere, he / she will be provisionally admitted on the basis of the attested copies of his/ her certificates. In such cases, the candidate must produce a letter from the Head of the college / institution concerned stating the fact. Once the admission has been granted, the candidate must deposit the original certificates within 15 days of his / her admission to AIFD Bangalore, failing which the admission of the candidate will be cancelled and the seat allotted to the next candidate in the waiting list.

#### 2.6 Withdrawal of Original Certificates.

In case a candidate admitted to AIFD Bangalore desires to withdraw his/ her original certificates in order to facilitate his / her admission to some other college / institute, he/ she will be permitted to do so for the period to be decided by AIFD Bangalore. In case the candidate does not deposit the withdrawn original certificates back with AIFD by the date specified by AIFD for the purpose, his / her admission will be cancelled and the seat allotted to the candidate next in merit.

#### 2.7 How to pay fee.

### 3. SELECTION PROCEDURES AND EXAMINATION CENTRES

#### 3.1 Selection Procedure for Computer Based Online Admission Test (OAT)

(a) **Date and Time of OAT.** The entrance test for admission to the UG Course offered by AIFD Bangalore, will be held online. The Online Admission Test (OAT) 2022 will be held on **Sunday 29 May 2022** from **1430 hrs to 1730 hrs** at the notified examination centres. The candidates are required to report at their respective examination centres at **1400 hrs** i.e. at least half an hour before the commencement of the OAT.

(b) **Examination Centres.**

Note : As the entrance exams will be held online, the detailed address of the centres will be available on the website and the admit cards, once registration is done.

Candidates will be asked to fill their choice for the examination centre they wish to appear for the OAT. As far as possible, the examination centres will be allotted to the candidates as per their first / second choice. However, in the event of minimum no of candidates not being available at a particular centre, the organizers have a right to allot any other centre to the candidate. In such a case, an attempt will be made to allot the examination centre closer to the candidate's first / second choice. But the test centre once allotted will be final and no request for its change will be entertained.

(c) **Nature of OAT.** OAT will consist of 100 Marks objective type test items to be responded to by the candidates in the allocated duration of three hours. The test will have the following components:-

- (i) Intelligence and Reasoning Test.
- (ii) General Awareness Test.
- (iii) English Language Competency & Comprehension Test. (including short essay)
  - (aa) The medium of the test shall be English only.
  - (ab) A sample Question Paper is given at Appendix 'A'.
  - (ac) No negative marking will be done.

- (d) **Merit list.** Merit lists for the institution UG Course will be according to candidates' performance in the OAT. In deciding about the inter-se-merit, tie if any, will be resolved in the following order of priority:-
- (i) Candidates securing higher marks in Language Competency & Comprehension Test component.
  - (ii) As per Candidates' performance and University admission approval.
- (e) **Use of Unfair Means in OAT.** Use of unfair means in OAT will render the candidate disqualified for admission to the course. Officer In charge Examination Centre is empowered to disqualify the candidates found using unfair means. Canvassing in any form or approaching the organizers through unfair means or influencing any of the authorities will also render the candidate disqualified for admission to the Course.
- (f) **Notification of Results OAT.** The result of the OAT will be declared on **10 Jun 2022**. The result will be available in the Institute Website [aifd.edu.in](http://aifd.edu.in)
- (g) **Final Authority on OAT.** The conduct of OAT, and the preparation of merit list etc is the sole responsibility of AIFD Bangalore. In case of any ambiguity / confusion, the decision of AIFD Bangalore will be final and binding.
- (h) **Request for Revaluation.** No request for revaluation of OAT Answer Sheet will be considered and no correspondence in this regard will be entertained.

## 4. HOW TO APPLY

### 4.1. Methodology.

- (a) Candidates are required to fill the Online Admission Application form for UG Course B.Sc FAD in the given link (will be notified in the website) before **05 May 2022**

Note:

1. Separate Hostel facilities are available for Boys and Girls
2. Admission for UG Course will be based on Online Admission Test (OAT) merit basis.
3. 54 seats are available for wards of Army Personnel out of 60 intake each for B.Sc FAD and B.Sc IDD courses.
4. Six seats are available for Karnataka Civilians (Students who have passed 12<sup>th</sup> Std Examination from Karnataka State Board Examination only) for both Courses.

### 4.2. Forms and Certificates.

All particulars / details sought from the candidate in the form should be provided and the columns completed and signed by the candidate himself / herself. Incomplete application forms will be rejected. There is no provision for condoning of the delay in the receipt of application forms on account of postal strikes / delays / lapse by courier services.

### 4.3. Furnishing of Incorrect Information.

If in case at any stage, it is found that a candidate has furnished false information in the application form or has produced false certificates, his / her admission, even if granted, will be cancelled and fees paid by him / her forfeited. Criminal proceedings may also be initiated against such candidates.

#### 4.4. Documents to be Submitted along with The Application Form.

Following documents will be enclosed with the application form and the candidates are advised to check the same before sending their form to AIFD, Bangalore :-

- (a) Admit Card and Attendance Card.
- (b) Proof of age as per Std X / XII or Equivalent Examination Mark-sheet /TC.
- (c) Statement of Marks of qualifying examination with aggregate marks.
- (d) Statement of Marks of higher degrees / examinations.
- (e) Appropriate certificates in respect of various categories to avail priority of admission which are as under :-
  - (i) Certificate No 1 (for children of serving Army Personnel having 10 years continuous service in the Army, Retired/Released/Discharged after 10 Years of service/killed in action/died during service/disabled in action/medically boarded out with pension).
  - (ii) Certificate No 2 (for step children of Army Personnel who were born from wedlock where at least one parent belonged to the Army/adopted children of Army Personnel who have been adopted at least 5 Years prior to commencement of course).
  - (iii) Certificate No 3 (for children of Army Medical Corps/AD Corps Officers serving in Air Force/Navy Medical Establishment/MNS/APS and TA Personnel).

#### 4.5. Admit Card

- (a) The admit card for the OAT will be available for downloading online after registration.
- (b) In case the admit card is not available online/received by the candidate by **27 May 2022** for OAT he / she should approach Principal, AIFD stating his / her full name, address and his / her application form number so as to facilitate the dispatch of the duplicate admit card (Telephone No of AIFD is 09035316000 / 8792669001).

#### 4.6. Appearing for OAT in the Event of Non Receipt of Admit Card.

In case a candidate does not receive the admit card prior to the date of examination, he / she must approach the official in charge of examination centre (centre as indicated in the application form as first choice) with passport size photograph similar to the photograph forwarded with the application form. He/She may permit the candidate to provisionally appear in the examination. However, evaluation of his / her answer sheet and admission to the course would in such a situation be subject to the confirmation of his / her eligibility for OAT.

- \*\* Messing Charges- Actuals will be charged on a monthly basis and the balance, if any, will be refunded / collected after the completion of the course. Institute reserves the right to change the Institute, Hostel & Messing Fee Structure without notice based on unforeseen increase in cost.
- University Registration / Examination Fee may change subject to increase as per university notification.
- Hostellers will have to buy Mattress & Pillow (one time) @ Rs 3500/ at the time of checking into the hostel.
- Students will have to incur a one time Uniform fee of Rs 6500/ for purchase of their uniforms at the time of reporting to to the Institute.

## 6. WILLINGNESS CERTIFICATE & REFUND RULES

6.1 Candidates will be required to deposit Rs 10,000/- by due date as mentioned in Admission Schedule for 2022. This amount will be adjusted against the first instalment of the fee when the candidate is admitted. After registering the willingness to join, if a candidate fails to report or withdraws from the course, refund of fee will be as per Paragraph 6.2 given below (written application for withdrawal should be given and the date of receipt of application will be considered for refund of money).

### 6.2 Refund of Registration Fees before commencement of the Course/Cut off Date.

In case of withdrawal before commencement of the course /cut off date (30 Jun 2022), full Registration fee less Rs 1,000/- processing charges will be refunded.

- (iii) Security Deposit – To be refunded.
- (iv) Student Association Fee – No refund.
- (v) Tuition Fee – One year fees to be retained (Adjusted against security deposit).
- (vi) Hostel Charges – One year Hostel charges to be retained.
- (vii) Messing – As per actual. A single day of the month will be treated as a month.
- (viii) Other Charges – As per actual. A single day of the month will be treated as a month.

(c) **Withdrawal of Students after First Year/Subsequent Years.** If a student withdraws after first year or later due to any reason whatsoever, clearance certificate would only be given to him/her after ensuring the following :-

- (i) Registration Fee – No refund.
- (ii) Admission Fee – No refund.
- (iii) Security Deposit – To be adjusted against tuition fee for balance period of the course.
- (iv) Student Association Fee – No refund.
- (v) Tuition Fee – To be charged for balance period of the entire course.
- (vi) Hostel Charges – Room rent for complete duration of the course to be charged.
- (vii) Messing – As per actual. A single day of the month will be treated as a month.
- (viii) Other Charges – As per actual. A single day of the month will be treated as a month.

**6.3 Jurisdiction of Court Cases.** All court cases and legal matters if any will be dealt within the jurisdiction of Bangalore only.

## 7. DISCIPLINE & OTHERS

7.1 **Dress Code** : All students are required to wear Institute uniform on working days.

7.2 **Attendance** : As per Bengaluru North University/Institute Norms, a student should maintain a minimum attendance of 75% in all the subjects failing which the student will not be permitted to appear for exams.

7.3 **Accident** : The Institute will not be responsible for any accident to the students during their training and stay at the Institute.

7.4 **Local Guardian** : The parents of the students should nominate a local guardian residing in Bangalore for immediate communication concerning the student.

7.5 **Contact Details** : Parent and student should register their Phone Numbers and E Mail ID for easy communication. Any change in their Phone Numbers or Mail ID to be brought to the knowledge of the institute.

7.6 **Campus Discipline** : The students should follow the directions of the institute administration, and Institute and Hostel timings. Parents can contact their respective wards mentors to get feed back on their wards regularity to classes and discipline. It will be brought to the knowledge of parent by SMS and E Mail.

7.7 **Smart / Dependent / ECHS Card** : Students are required to bring their respective cards, to avail the benefits of Command Hospital and other facilities.

7.8 **Residential College**: It is a 100% residential College and it is compulsory for UG students who take admission to reside in the hostel. The parent has to take approval from management to keep their ward as day scholar.

7.9 **Personal Vehicle**: Institute discourages students from having their personnel vehicle in the campus. In case it is to be maintained, the student to submit a copy of driving license, RC and Tax paid receipt to the Institute and take permission to keep the vehicle.

### 7.11. Ragging.

Ragging is banned in educational Institution and hostels and any one indulging in such acts shall be subject to punishment by a Court of Law / concerned authorities. The following extract and copy of letter are appended below :-

(a) Extract from the circular No ED 99 URC 99 dated 16 Aug 1999 issued by the Education Department, Govt of Karnataka, reproduced in Karnataka Education Act, 1983 (Karnataka Act No. 1 of 1995) Section 2 (29) "Ragging" means causing inducing, compelling or forcing a student, whether by way of a practical joke or otherwise, to do any act which detracts from human dignity or violated his persons or exposes him to ridicule or to forbear from doing any lawful act, by intimidating wrongfully restraining, wrongfully confining or injuring him or by using criminal force to him or by holding out to him any treat of such intimidation, wrongful restraint, wrongful confinement, injury or the use of criminal force".

(b) Army HQ AWES letter No B/45807/WC/AWES/CW-09 dated 26 Apr 2000.

(i) Some instances of ragging of students of most unbecoming and inhuman nature have been reported in AWES run Army Public Schools and vocational institutions. Such cases, besides damaging a student's psyche, adversely affect the reputation of the Army in general and the AWES run institutions.

(ii) With immediate effect all forms of ragging will be strictly forbidden in AWES run institutions.

(iii) Management must ensure strict compliance and take strict disciplinary action against defaulters.

(iv) This has the approval of the Adjutant General.

(c) Ragging is not allowed in the college. Students accused of ragging and found guilty after due investigations, would be expelled from the college.



## **RULES AND DISCIPLINE FOR ADMISSION IN HOSTEL:-**

- 1) Admission is open to full time students of AIFD..
- 2) The application form completed in all respects should be submitted to the Office of the AIFD  
on any working day during office hours.
- 3) Admission to the Hostel will be cancelled if incomplete or false information is furnished.
- 4) Students will be required to vacate the room within 5 days on completion of the scheduled examination each semester.
- 5) Students are allowed to stay in the Hostel during the Winter / Summer vacations only for internship
- 6) Hostel fee for the next academic year is required to be paid in the month of February to April.
- 7) AIFD reserves its right to cancel admission of undeserving students without giving any reason.
- 8) AIFD reserves its right to increase the hostel fee, if necessary.
- 9) AIFD will not be responsible for any mishap.
- 10) Student residing in the Hostel managed by AIFD shall strictly observe all the Rules and Regulations in force from time to time. Breach of rules / regulations may invite rustication / fine.
- 11) During their stay in the Hostel they will be under the control of the Officials of AIFD
- 12) Smoking, consumption of alcoholic drinks and spitting is strictly prohibited in the hostel premises.
- 13) No guest or visitor of the inmate will be permitted to visit rooms. Visitors and guests should be received in the Visitors room or Reception area only between 9.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m.
- 14) Every student shall be in his / her hostel by 9.00 p.m. If he / she has to stay out after the said timing owing to any special reason, he / she must obtain prior permission from the Registrar. The application for leave of absence from the hostel shall be made in writing thru Dean/HOD/Mentor to the principal and Registrar and his/her permission shall be obtained. Late entry without prior permission will invite penalty / rustication.
- 15) No students shall use the service of a hostel servant for personal work even on payment. He/she shall also not bring any servant from outside even temporarily.
- 16) Students will not enter rooms of other students without permission of the inmates. Students should not go to other students flat after 10.00 p.m. in the night.

- 17) Every case of illness and accident must be reported immediately to the Warden and Registrar.
- 18) No functions or celebrations shall be organized except with the permission of the Registrar.
- 19) Resident students are not permitted to convene any meeting of any sort under any circumstances anywhere in the Hostel premises without the prior permission of the Registrar or the Management.
- 20) No poster etc. should be put up anywhere, either in rooms or lobbies.
- 21) Students are not allowed to play any kind of sports in the room.
- 22) Throwing of water, colour etc. on one another and on the walls / property of the hostel is strictly prohibited.
- 23) Students suffering from any contagious disease will not be allowed to stay in the hostel. Decision of the Registrar in this regard will be final and binding.
- 24) Allotment of the room, furniture etc. will be entirely at the discretion of the Registrar / Warden and no complaint in this regard will be entertained.
- 25) Every student shall keep the room allotted to him clean and neat. He / She shall take proper care of the furniture and fixtures handed over to him / her. The hostel authorities have the right to enter and inspect the rooms at any time, even in the absence of students.
- 26) All matters relating to differences among students and complaints about the hostel servants shall be brought to the notice of the Registrar, who will take such action as may be necessary. No police complaint will be lodged by the students before taking prior permission from the Registrar.
- 27) Students are expected to switch off the lights and fans in their rooms every time they go out and take precautions to economise electricity consumption.
- 28) Charges for any damages to the property as well as to the furniture and fixtures caused by a student/students negligence will be recovered from the student/students staying in the said room.
- 29) Student should not drive nails, screws etc. into the wall or doors. No repair shall be done by the students themselves. They should approach the Registrar/Warden who will arrange for repairs.
- 30) Hostel is meant only for the use of bonafide students of that particular hostel. Visitors are not allowed to enter any room.
- 31) The Hostel Authorities do not hold themselves responsible for the safe custody of the property of the students staying in the hostel. Students should provide their own locks and should take proper care of their belongings. They should not leave the key of the room anywhere around. AIFD will not be responsible for the loss of personal belongings of the students.
