**CHANGE IN ADMISSION PROCEDURE AND ADMISSION  
ELIGIBILITY TO AIHM&CT AND AIFD, BENGALURU**

1. The competent authority has approved the following amendments in eligibility condition for admission and admission procedure in AIHM&CT and AIFD, Bengaluru from Academic Year 2025-2026 :-

(a) **Eligibility for Admission.** Eligibility conditions for admission will be as follows :-

(i) **Priority I.** Children of serving and retired Armed Forces (IA/IN/IAF) personnel as per auth distributions of seats be offered admission first. Once, the candidates list is exhausted, the admission should be offered to Priority II to IV applicants.

(ii) **Priority II.** Children of serving Paramilitary Forces pers like Assam Rifles and Coast Guard etc and children of retired paramilitary forces personnel granted regular pension, liberalized family pension, family pension, disability pension at the time of their superannuation, demise, discharge release medical board/invalided medical board and spouses/widows of serving armed forces personnel.

(iii) **Priority III.** Children of serving Central Armed Police Forces like CRPF, BSF, ITBP etc.

(iv) **Priority IV.** Civilians, not more than 10 % of sanctioned str of the course if vacancies exists after considering other eligible categories.

(b) **Admission Procedure.** The admission procedure will be as follows :-

(i) No OAT/WAT will be conducted.

(ii) Admission will be based on marks obtained in Class X and XII instead of WAT/OAT. The merit list would be prepared on the basis of marks obtained in Class X and XII in 40:60 weightage ratio and online interview by a BOO.

(iii) Provisional admission to students appearing for Class XII examination based on Class XI marks, if they score 50% marks and above in Class XI after being interviewed by a BOO. However final admission will be based on meeting the eligibility criteria.

2. The ibid amendments may pl be read in conjunction with the admission eligibility and admission procedure laid down vide AWES Blue Book and HQ AWES letter No B/45840/SOP/AWES dt 01 May 2024 and applicable for AIHM&CT and AIFD only.
